Position Available: Part-Time Health Justice Outreach Coordinator

The NWBCCC is a 45-year-old grassroots member-led community-based organization that unites individuals and institutions to fight for racial and economic justice. NWBCCC is a membership-based organization that uses direct action community organizing to address housing justice, public education, immigrant rights, the school-to-prison pipeline, voting rights, economic development, community development, access to quality health care, and fight for broader policy change in the Bronx and beyond.

We believe that healthcare is a human right and that Bronxites have the right to access quality affordable care. Thus, the health justice outreach coordinator's main responsibilities will be to:

- Coordinate weekly and monthly outreach events to promote the NYC Care initiative, a municipal health access option through Health and Hospitals for New Yorkers who are currently uninsured,
- Support the continued development of the NWBCCC Health Justice Committee and support staff tabling events, health fairs, and community events in the Bronx that address any of the social determinants of health.
- Facilitate workshops and info-sessions on NYC Care and other health justice initiatives at community organizations and houses of worship across the Bronx
- Base-building through membership recruitment of community and faith-based institutions
- Support with follow-up and one on one meetings with community members interested in the NYC Care and other health justice initiatives
- Conduct leadership development to build the capacity of community leaders and members
- Coordinate with other issue area committees to engage them in NYC Care outreach efforts, referrals, and enrollment

Requirements:

- Minimum of one year experience in community organizing, successfully conducting big-scale outreach efforts preferred
- Experience with door-knocking, phone banking, and conducting one on one meetings
