About the position: We seek an energetic organizer who will help support thousands of fast food workers in building Fast Food Justice.

Responsibilities include:

- Organize fast food workers in New York City to build Fast Food Justice;
- Identify and develop worker leaders;
- Help fast food workers and community members understand their rights under New York City legislation that affects industry working conditions; and
- Assist in planning and running meetings and actions of workers and community members including know-your-rights trainings.

Requirements include:

- Demonstrated commitment to social justice;
- Organizing or community work, or volunteer experience;
- The ability and willingness to travel if needed and to work long or irregular hours, including weekend work as needed;
- Strong and effective verbal communication and presentation skills;
- Excellent writing and computer skills;
- Strong interpersonal skills;
- Experience and ability to work with people from diverse backgrounds;
- Fluency in a second language, either Spanish, Bengali or Haitian Creole, preferred; and
- A car and a valid driver's license, a plus.
