Position: Outreach Specialist

Cypress Hills Local Development Corporation has an opening for one (1) full-time Outreach Specialist in the Community Organizing and Advocacy Division. This position will be part of CHLDC's East New York displacement prevention initiative which will pioneer a holistic approach to displacement prevention that encompasses a data-driven early warning system: extensive outreach and education to low income renters, homeowners, small businesses and manufacturers; engaging houses of worship and public schools in education efforts; ramped up housing counseling and business assistance; and policy advocacy and community organizing around land use actions and programs/financing needed by vulnerable populations in East New York. CHLDC hopes to enlist residents, merchants, manufacturers, houses of worship, schools and other community based organizations in a neighborhood wide campaign to track, get ahead of and combat displacement of low income renters, homeowners and other vulnerable populations in East New York.

Principal Duties:

- Conduct outreach to East New York residents, merchants, manufacturers, houses of worship, schools and other community based organizations
- Connect these stakeholders to needed services, such as tenant counseling, homeowner counseling, and youth and family services
- Connect these stakeholders to community organizing opportunities, such as tenant organizing, merchant organizing, and neighborhood-wide organizing for a fair and just East New York (through the Coalition for Community Advancement: Progress for East New York/Cypress Hills)
- Establish and lead outreach plan that engages residents and community institutions and ensures robust neighborhood participation and investment in the programs
- Maintain the Coalition for Community Advancement's Facebook page
- Recommend new methods of communicating with audiences such as apps, group text messages, automated phone calls, webinars, podcasts, or other social media outlets.
- Demonstrate commitment to leadership development, community building, and • community organizing as strategies for social change

• Perform other duties as assigned as necessary for the success of the displacement prevention program

- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Some experience in outreach
- Good relational skills and demonstrated proficiency working in a community-based setting
