SBIDC is offering a six month paid fellowship for a Revitalization Fellow to work on several of our economic development projects as part of our Business Services team. The Revitalization Fellow's primary responsibilities will be centered around our commercial revitalization programs in Red Hook. The Fellow will work with the Economic Development Program Manager to plan and execute two street fairs on Van Brunt Street in Red Hook, one in June and one in October. The Fellow will also be responsible for maintaining various administrative tasks for the commercial revitalization business attraction program, including website, social media and database updates.
