Supportive Housing Social Worker Casa Mutua

Lenox Hill Neighborhood House, widely recognized as one of New York’s premier human services providers, is a 122-year-old settlement house that provides an extensive array of effective and integrated services—social, educational, legal, health, housing, mental health, nutritional and fitness—which significantly improve the lives of 15,000 people in need each year, ages 3 to 103, on the East Side of Manhattan. Our constituents include older adults, homeless and formerly homeless adults, children and families, recent immigrants, disabled persons, adult learners and thousands more. Our programs—staffed by social workers, educators, public interest lawyers, case managers, advocates and many, many others—include an Early Childhood Center, RealArts After School Program and Summer Camp, Women’s Mental Health Shelter, permanent supportive housing residence, two Senior Centers, transportation program for frail seniors, caregivers programs, social adult day program, case management program for frail seniors, transportation program, Food Services, Legal Advocacy Department, Visual and Performing Arts, Fitness & Aquatics, Adult Education and more. Casa Mutua, located on East 102nd Street, is our 54-unit permanent supportive housing residence for formerly homeless single adults with histories of mentally illness and substance abuse. We are seeking a **Supportive Housing Social Worker** to join our team to promote the independence and stability of our tenants by providing comprehensive supportive services.

Reporting to the Casa Mutua Director, the **Supportive Housing Social Worker** will be responsible for providing direct service to tenants including assessment, supportive counseling, case management, advocacy for entitlements and services, group work and referral to resources including psychiatric and medical care, civil legal services, substance abuse services, etc. H/she will be expected to participate in a teamwork approach to service provision, and work cooperatively with staff at all levels at Casa Mutua and throughout Lenox Hill Neighborhood House to ensure quality service provision. The **Supportive Housing Social Worker** will also be responsible for completing comprehensive assessments to inform, develop and implement service plans, participating in case conferences and staff meetings, escorting tenants to appointments as needed, assisting tenants in problem-solving and conflict resolution, and attending and facilitating group activities including monthly parties, meals and groups to model appropriate social behavior and build relationships with tenants. 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Supportive Housing Social Worker will be expected to perform other related duties incidental to the work as assigned.

Qualifications:

The successful applicant must possess excellent interpersonal, engagement, and relationship building skills. A social justice perspective combined with a commitment to the well-being of mentally ill and homeless populations is required. Additionally, experience working in a residential environment providing support around the issues of substance abuse and trauma informed care and treatment are strongly desired. The successful candidate must also be detail-oriented and have excellent communication, computer and organizational abilities. MSW or other relevant Master's degree preferred; BSW with relevant experience will be considered. Spanish proficiency preferred.
